

Confirmation Life Groups or “C-Life”

What can I expect at a C-Life Group? Every other week you will get together with 10 – 12 other students from your Confirmation class. Usually you all meet in a persons home for about an hour and a half. There will be snacks, games, and discussion time. It is a chance for you to process what is going on in your life and relate with other students who are in confirmation.

What do I need to bring to C-Life? You should bring your Confirmation Binder, your Bible, and your “Case for Faith” book and a pen.

What do I need to have prepared for C-life? The C-life leaders who are leading your small group will help you know what to prepare. You just need to show up for the first one ready and eager to learn. Throughout the year you will be reading a book called “Case for Faith by Lee Strobel. Each C-life group there will be pages for you to read and questions to answer before the next meeting. You can find that information in your binder.

What if I have a conflict and I need to miss a meeting? We understand that your lives are busy and many other things are going on. It would be great if you had perfect attendance, but we understand things come up. If you know you have a conflict, let your leader know by calling them or emailing them. You should make sure that you are at C-life at least 8 times. If this becomes a problem, let the Youth Minister know as soon as possible so we can switch you into a group that might work better with your schedule. We don’t want you to miss out on this great experience.
